### What is involved?

Plymouth Tree Partnership wants people to appreciate and enjoy the city's trees. Guided walks in summer are one way to do that and to encourage more people to get active with trees. Walks need to be planned well in advance and this can be done with volunteers who have led walks previously. They will explain what works best and how to deal with different situations. They will also help with preparing promotional materials.

- The opportunity to plan and prepare an event involving safe-working practices.
- The opportunity to improve your knowledge of local trees and nature as a whole.

- Meeting others with similar interests.

### Things that Guided Walks Leaders do:

- Researching an area of interest and devising a suitable walk.
- Planning the event so that it is safe and enjoyable.
- Meeting attendees and making them feel welcome.
- Leading the walk so that it is interesting and informative.
